Tips for writing a letter:
To a Senator:

Dear Mr./Mrs./Ms. Last Name

State the purpose of writing your letter in the first sentence. Correctly identify the piece of legislation such as House bills are H.R.____; and Senate bills are S.____.
Be COURTEOUS.

If appropriate, include personal information about why the issue matters to you and address only ONE issue in each letter or e-mail.

If you are telephoning, a staff member will take your call. Ask to speak to the aide who handles that specific issue. Identify yourself as a constituent and tell the aide you would like to leave a BRIEF message about the issue whether you favor the issue or against the issue and your reasons. Be NICE!

If you are in the Washington, DC and want to see your Senator or Representative, you MUST make an appointment and your meeting will be very brief!
